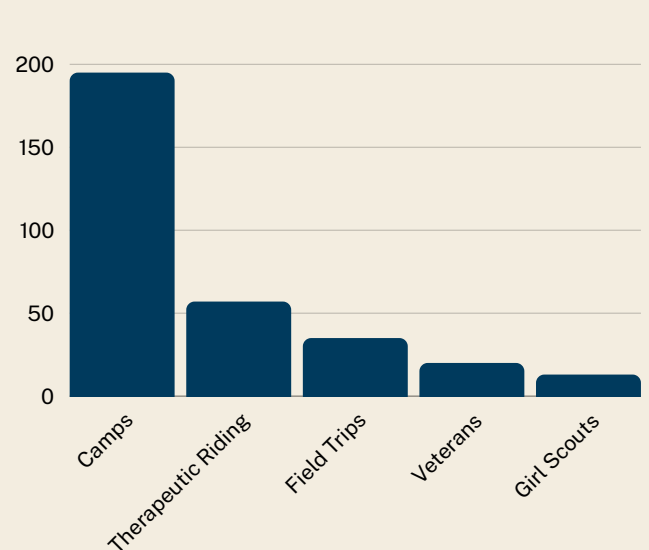

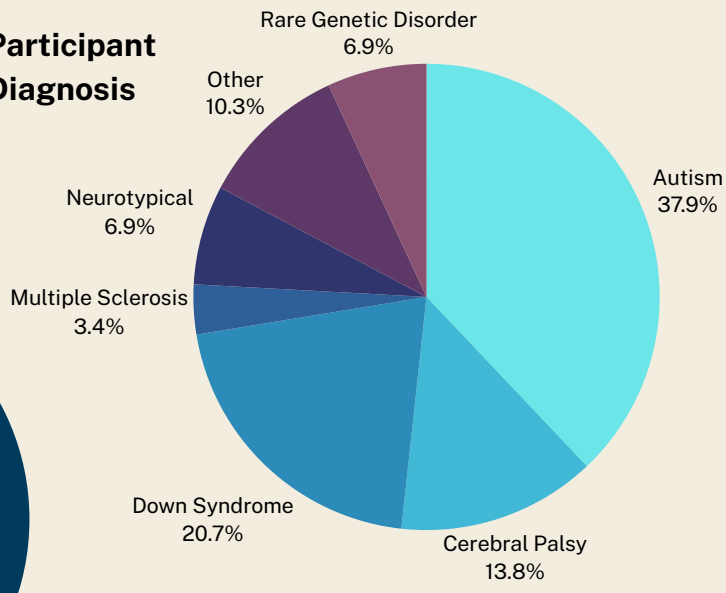

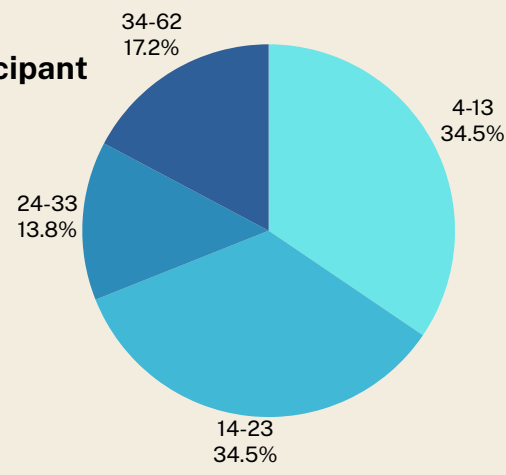

Participant Diagnosis



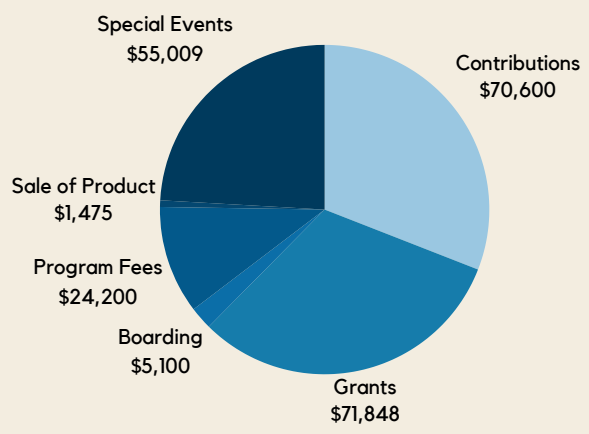
Participant Age



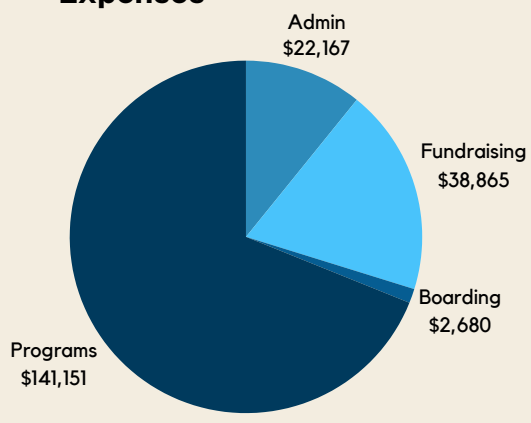
