Benefits of EAS

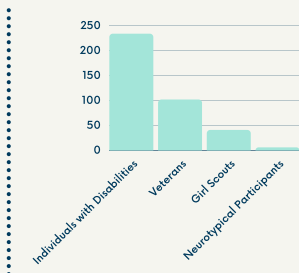
Physical: postural improvement, improved balance, normalization of tone, increased strength

Social-Emotional: self-confidence, empathy, joy, relationship building, social skills

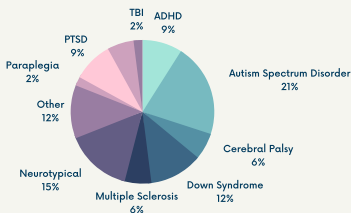
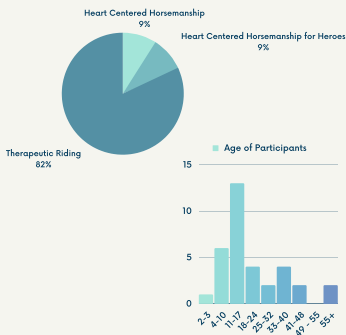
Sensory Integration: establish rhythm, stimulation, self-regulation

Participants Served YTD



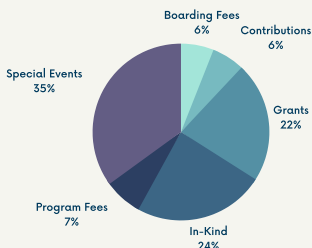
Programs & Participants in 2021

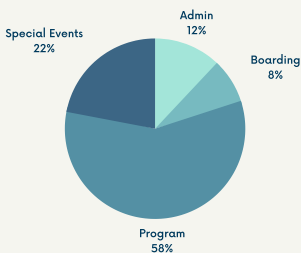
